Job Overview

The ESL teacher is responsible for planning and implementing English as a second language classes for adult learners in the LINC – Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada program.

Role and Responsibilities

- Plan and teach settlement focussed lessons each week to a group of adult learners
- Plan course content based on results of student needs assessment
- Implement portfolio based language assessment (PBLA) for each learner
- Assess participants' language learning and settlement needs on an ongoing basis and prepare reports based on Canadian Language Benchmarks
- Provide information, referral, bridging and support services to assist participants to access other community resources and programs
- Work co-operatively with the on-site child care staff to provide support to parents and their children when necessary
