

Volunteers with Middle to Higher Level French Communicative Ability Needed

At WELARC, we are in the process of training new assessors to use the Batterie de tests de classement aux Niveaux de compétence linguistique canadiens (BTC-NCLC), for placement into IRCC funded French language training programs. In order to be certified, new assessors must complete 3 assessments at different levels of proficiency.

We are currently looking for volunteers with middle to higher level French communicative ability who might come in and do the entire test as a training opportunity for our assessors. The intention is that we might fill up as many spots as possible, for the week of February 11.

There is no compensation for taking the test, but it would be great experience for students of the language!

- The test is purely voluntary, but will be recorded for training purposes
- A consent form / confidentiality agreement will be signed
- The test will take about 3 hours to complete (or less)
- No results will be given
- Because this is a volunteer opportunity, purely for training, it is not necessary that test takers be permanent residents.

Volunteer testing for certification will take place the week of February 11, but we may be able to use volunteers at other times, as available.
