

## Living English for Employment Call for Educational Assistants 2019

Living English for Employment (LEE) is a 7-week summer program for adult newcomers (Literacy-CLB 4), starting July 8th, 2018 until August 23rd, 2019. LEE provides students with in class work related English practice and weekly on-site work experience. Classes will be held at the Red River College downtown Princess street campus.

The contract is for 15 hours a week for 8 weeks including training and development time during Curriculum Training. Curriculum training starts June 24th-28th, 2019 (times TBA) and classes begin July 8th - August 23rd, 2019. The hourly rate is \$15.

### ***Living English for Employment Educational Assistants will:***

- Aid in the delivery of EAL lessons to classes of approximately 15 students, Monday to Friday, 9:00am to 12:00pm from July 8th - August 23rd, 2019
- Assist teacher in class and on weekly work placements
- Participate in curriculum development and collaborate with coordinators and other *Living English for Employment* teachers during Curriculum Training
- Encourage student interaction, celebrate cultural diversity, and stimulate all learning styles (visual, kinaesthetic, auditory, global, linear)
- Assist students in developing language skills and strategies needed to communicate in real-life and workplace situations

### ***Living English for Employment Educational Assistants need:***

- Proficient skills in one of the following areas sewing, computers, gardening, nutrition and leather working
- Basic computer skills, be open to professional development, able to work in a team, and create interactive lessons
- To be a positive role model and build positive relationships with students
