

Living English for Employment

Call for Teachers 2019



Living English for Employment (LEE) is a 7 week summer program starting July 8th until August 23th, 2019 that provides students with in-class work- related English practice and weekly on-site work experience in the areas of nutrition, gardening, computers, sewing and leatherworking. Classes will be held at the Red River College downtown Princess street campus. We are looking for teachers to teach classes ranging from Literacy to CLB 4 and who have skills in the areas listed above.

The teaching contract is from July 8th to August 23th, 2019 from 9:00 am -12:00 pm including training and development time during Curriculum Training (Week of June 24-28, times TBA). Payment will be in the form of a \$4,500 professional consultant's fee (paid out bi-weekly).

Living English for Employment teachers will:

- Prepare and deliver EAL lessons to classes of approximately 15 students on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Fridays, 9:00 am to 12:00 pm from July 9th to August 24th, 2018.
- Accompany students on job placements every Thursday
- Participate in curriculum development and collaborate with Coordinators and other Living English for Employment teachers during Curriculum Training
- Encourage student interaction, celebrate cultural diversity, and stimulate all learning styles (visual, kinesthetic, auditory, global, linear)
- Assist students in developing language skills and strategies needed to communicate in everyday life and work related English

Living English for Employment teachers need:

- TESL Certificate or equivalent
- Knowledge of the Canadian Language Benchmarks document
- Proficient skills in one of the following areas: sewing, leatherworking, computers, nutrition, or gardening.
 - Basic computer skills, be open to professional development, able to work in a team, and create interactive lessons

Experience in literacy and low-level classes and in one of the skills mentioned above is an asset please highlight any such experience in your resume & cover letter.
