Rationale:

- MANSO would like to provide information about our future membership fees in advance, so that members can plan ahead.
- Currently, membership fees require smaller organizations to dedicate a larger percentage of their settlement budget than larger organizations. The suggested increase in 2020-21 keeps fees accessible for smaller organizations.
- Membership fees provide resources to the umbrella to conduct activities not covered by IRCC funding. These include:
 - Core activities (Annual general meeting; other membership meetings; travel for board meetings)
 - Accessibility (PD access fund, travel subsidies)
 - Special projects (frontline worker PD events)
- In addition, these funds give the umbrella some stability, in the event that IRCC funding is decreased or withdrawn.
