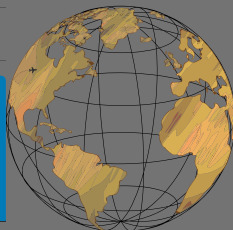
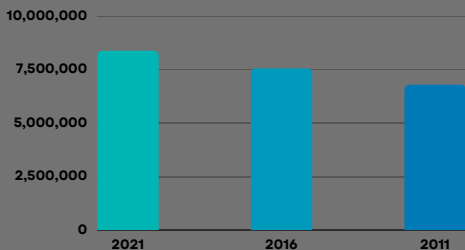




# IMMIGRATION IN CANADA - AT A GLANCE

## Number of immigrants to Canada

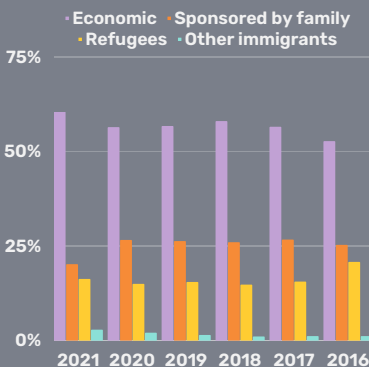


From 2016 to 2021 about 1,328,240 immigrants arrived in Canada. These recent immigrants made up 15.9% of the immigrant population

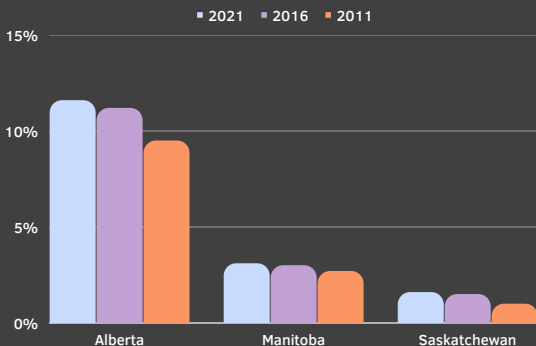
## Top 5 non-official languages spoken most often at home by recent immigrants

The top racialized group in the Prairie provinces are Filipinos. In 2021, more than 1 in 4 Filipinos in Canada lived in the CMAs of Calgary (9.3%), Winnipeg (8.8%) and Edmonton (8.4%).
