Rationale:

- MANSO is providing information about our future membership fees in advance, so that members can plan ahead for budget preparation.
- Membership fees provide resources to the umbrella to conduct activities not covered by IRCC or Provincial funding. These include:
 - Core activities (Annual general meeting; other membership meetings; advocacy activities, supporting sector events)
 - Accessibility (PD access fund, travel subsidies)
 - Special projects (member events)
- MANSO recognizes that many member agencies are facing decreased funding in 2025-2026, although Membership costs are usually calculated based on the previous year's settlement budget, please contact MANSO if there is a rationale for basing it on 2025-2026 funding amounts.
- These funds support the rise in costs of programming and give the umbrella some stability, in the event that Government funding is decreased or withdrawn.
