End Homelessness Winnipeg is recruiting independent directors to serve on its Board of Directors for terms of three (3) years, with the opportunity to renew.

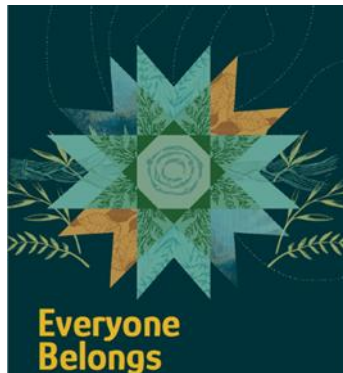
About End Homelessness Winnipeg (EHW)

We are an Indigenous non-profit organization leading collaborative efforts to ensure everyone has a place to call home. Partnering with a strong network of service providers and sector partners, we invest, advocate, and coordinate to drive change. Our mission is clear and unwavering: end homelessness.

Eligibility and Expertise

Directors must be at least 18 years of age. The Board of Directors reflects a broad range of knowledge, skills, and experiences. Specific expertise sought at this time includes:

- People with Lived Experience of homelessness
- People with an Accounting/Finance background (CPA)
- Indigenous Youth (aged 18-29)
- People with experience in Housing Development
- People with Law/Legal expertise

EHW is an Indigenous organization that serves the whole community. Seventy-five percent (75%) of elected Board members must be First Nations, Métis, or Inuit.

About the Board of Directors

The Board consists of up to twenty-two (22) Directors. The Board usually meets approximately eight (8) times per year, including an Annual General Meeting (AGM) held in September. Most meetings are held during weekday afternoons for approximately two hours.

Directors are volunteers. Directors with Lived Experience of homelessness who are currently experiencing homelessness and do not have their time paid by a host organization may be provided with honoraria.

The Governance Committee of the Board of Directors shall:

- receive nominations
- review each candidate's qualifications
- contact eligible candidates to confirm their interest and answer questions, and
- prepare appropriate information to assist End Homelessness Winnipeg members in the election process.

Directors shall be elected by members at the Annual General Meeting on Friday, September 25, 2026.
